There was a good turn out of 50 riders for the first round of the Thames Club Championship and Annual Charity Trial at Reel Hall Farm, Shamley Green, where they had to tackle 4 laps of 10 testing sections, plotted by Simon Dowling, Bob Brown Mike and Peter Powdrell. A light dusting of snow and icy conditions greeted the course plotters and some of the large logs were not included but on the day the weather was sunny but cold and riding conditions perfect. Best ride of the day was by Alan Ayres in winning the Expert class remaining feet up for the entire course, followed home by Mike Powdrell and Liam Thomas. There was an enormous concrete slab in section 5 which needed pinpoint throttle control to avoid dropping back down or looping the bike, Alan's control was perfect.

Simon Mepham on his trusty Honda was best of the inter riders with feet up rides through Section 6 twisting around the trees on a leafy bank with a jump through the Vee in one tree. Simon Dowling enjoyed his own course and came out the winner of the Novice class but there was a close tussle behind him for second place between riding pals Andrew Williams, Josh Paterson and Glen Jarvis. Paul Sims triumphed in the Over 50 class on the red route from Pete Haines with a close battle for third between Ray Broughton and Shaun Wallis, Paul was best at Section 7 twisting around the trees on a leafy bank with a log to jump over.

Rupert Kemp had a trouble free run on the wobbler route and romped home ahead of Bob Brown and Peter Martire. Rupert enjoyed riding up and down the sandy banks and between the concrete steps at Section 8. There was a small youth entry and Jordan Fletcher mixed it well with his adult counterparts on the expert route but couldn't manage that big slab at Section 5. Charlie Woodward just beat Tom O'Sullivan on the inter route with better rides at Section 2 over the tree trunks and concrete rubble. Adam Thomas easily beat Grace Dark to win the youth novice class, Adam had good rides at Section 1 through a hollow over some rocks and out over a log.

From the proceeds of the trial the club was able to make a substantial donation to the Disabled Horse Riders, the landowner Doug Chandler's chosen charity.

Seventy Members turned out to skate the Ice covered slopes and hills. Clerk of Course Martin Kemp with brother Rupert got the dry half just right, but the wet half was ok when frozen but as it thawed the scores mounted.

Expert Winner Stephen Rees only stopped moving once and this was on his third lap at Section Eight which involved a uphill climb over a fallen tree and ultra slippery cambers to negotiate. Runner-up James Graham had four failures, one of them on this same Section.

Reynard Norris had a brilliant ride losing just twenty nine marks on the Intermediate Route to win the Class, with Daryl Dale in second place, and Aaron Dibnah was third just two marks behind.

Novice winner Andrew Williams must of had wings on his Montesa two stroke to scale those icy/muddy climbs of the later Sections that most other riders failed, the best rider of the Novice route is normally one of the very Old Over fifty riders but Andrew Blitzed them to-day, Tom Sherlock was a distant runner-up.

Veteran all rounder Vic Allan was the winner of the Pre sixty seven Class on a very smart 250 Triumph.

There were seven Over Forty Class riders riding the Intermediate route and Keith Cannom riding his daughters 125 Beta took the win from Iain Craddock.

Mick Edwards rode the entire course penalty free to win the wobbler class at the third round of the 2010 Thames Club Championship held at Quarry Trials in Betchworth, where riders had to tackle 4 laps of 10 sections set out by Keith & Frazer Cannom, Luke Thomas, Steve & Lewis Farmer. The banks were mainly dry after a week of fine weather but the exposed roots were made slippery by the overnight frost, the course plotters made sure that the sections were very interesting making best use of some tight turns around the trees.

Peter Matire followed Mick home with a three on section one and four miserly dabs with Jim Sherlock in third place. Returnee Jamie Rowden had a super ride to loose only 8 marks on the testing expert route with course plotter Luke Thomas in second place, Luke's downfall was section 5 which he failed to clean on the slippery chalk.

Jim Howell topped the Inters and was the best at Section 4 up and down a rooty bank with a large log to jump up and over, Mark Ward was second and Tom Horsburgh third. There was a close battle for honours in the Over 40 class with Steve Wells reigning supreme over Mick Huskinson and Chris Dark, good feet up rides from Steve on the steep climbs of Section eight. There was another close tussle for victory in the novice class where Shaun Fishwick just beat Peter Steer by 4 marks and Peter was just a dab better than Pete Tombling, Shaun has feet up rides through section six a steep drop into a hollow with a climb out over exposed roots.

Riding the same route Pete Haines lost a meagre dab at Section three up and down a rooty bank to win the Over 50 class, Paul Sims had an uncharacteristic 5 which put him down in second place with returnee Ken Gregory in third. Riding a mixture of red and yellow routes Steph Tombling was a worthy winner with Ian Carter in second place, feet up rides from Steph at Section two snaking amongst the trees. Frazer Cannom was out on his own in Youth Expert with all cleans at Section 2 dropping down and up a steep bank; Jake Pope beat Charlie Woodward to win Youth Inters class, good clean rides at the difficult sixth section.
